All members support and encourage one another towards individual growth, which in turn raises the overall achievement of the entire team.

## Attendance for the full schedule of marching band events are required!

Performance Standards- Excellence in performance begins with excellence in preparation. Preparation outside of rehearsal is necessary for the band to achieve its true potential. Everyone in the marching band is committed to standards of performance that result in full effort and involvement both on and off the band field.

Behavior- The members of the Marching Knights represent not only the marching band and music department, but all of Cave Spring High School and the entire Roanoke County school district as a result. All school rules apply at every band event.

PDA- Students should follow school guidelines in regards to public displays of affection. This makes other students uncomfortable will can not be tolerated. Students will be separated after a warning is issued. Students that violate school policies during rehearsal, at football games, competitions, or otherwise will be subject to all applicable disciplinary measures put in place by the Cave Spring Student Behavior code found in the student handbook.

Financial Considerations- Members must pay the band activity fees to participate in marching band. so please consider attending meetings every third Wednesday in the CSHS band room at 6:30. The calendar has the meetings listed as well.

Preparation- Students commit to coming to all rehearsals fully prepared, with instrument/equipment in good working order and ALL necessary items. Students are required to dress in appropriate clothing and wear close-toed shoes.

Commitment and Attendance- Attendance at all rehearsals and performances is mandatory. Students who choose to participate in marching band are committing to being present and early for all rehearsals and performances for the full season. Please keep the following in mind regarding attendance:

- Absences are considered excused when permission is given in advance for a requested absence (a minimum of two weeks in advance) OR when a parent or guardian contacts band staff of a religious obligation or an emergency, such as severe illness, death in the family, or otherwise
- Absences are considered unexcused when a student misses rehearsal without approval, or when they are absent from rehearsal for a situation on the unexcused absence list (see next bullet point)
- Absences that are NEVER considered excused include the following: Homework, studying for tests, work, parties, music lessons, driving lessons, babysitting, and other similar activities.
- Excessive absences or an absence very close to a performance may result in a student not being permitted to perform or, in severe situations, possible removal from the ensemble
- If you are ever in doubt as to whether an absence is considered excused, please reach out to band staff.

Communication- The staff and directors believe that communication is a key component to excellence. The primary form of communication will be through email. Students and parents should make sure that their contact information is updated, and email is checked consistently. The calendar can be found on the band website; please note all dates and time.

Parents are tasked with ensuring that their child is at least 15-20 minutes early to all rehearsals and performances. Unlike many sports teams, there is no way to substitute for band members who do not attend. No one is on the "bench," and we do not have second strings; missing even one person from a rehearsal or performance affects every other member of the band!
